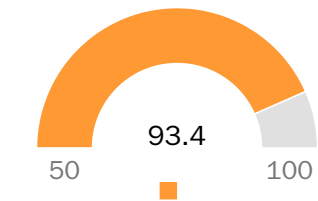

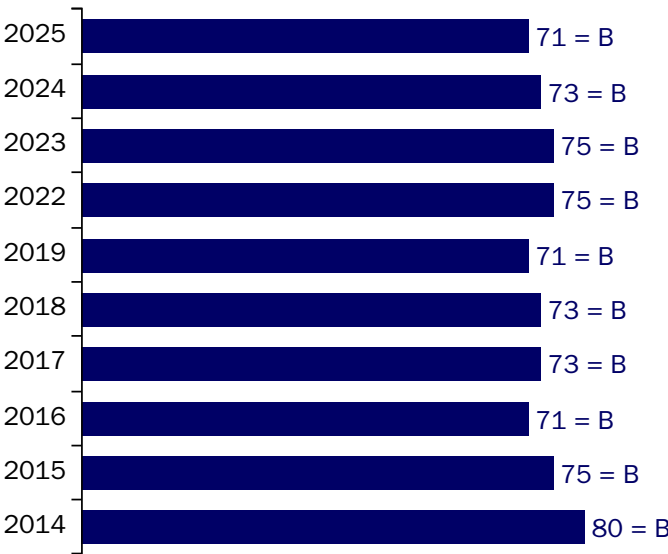

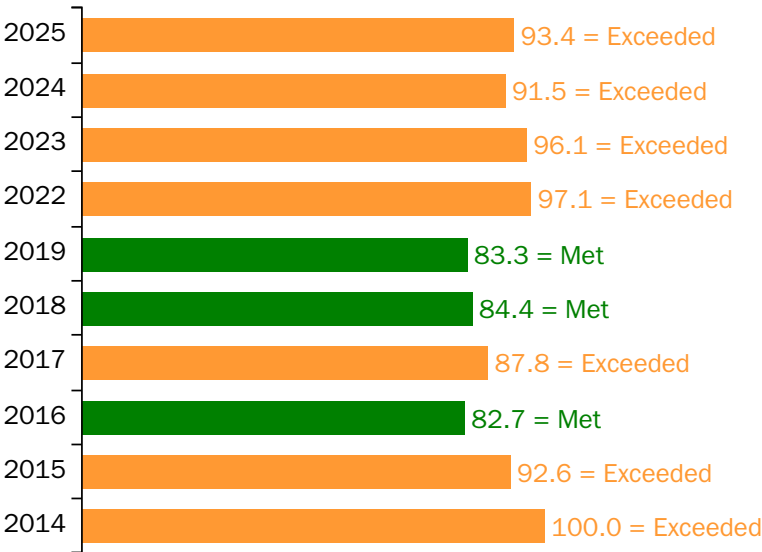

Academic Growth History

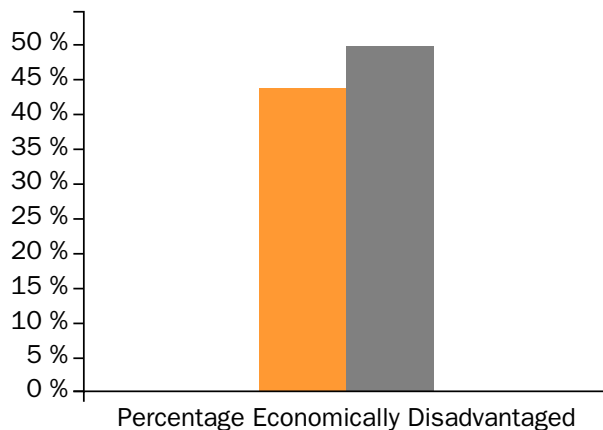

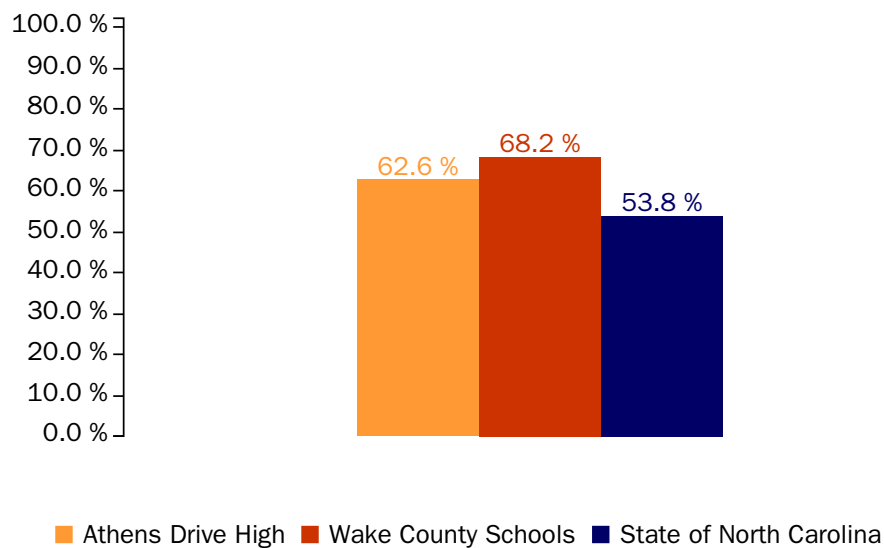

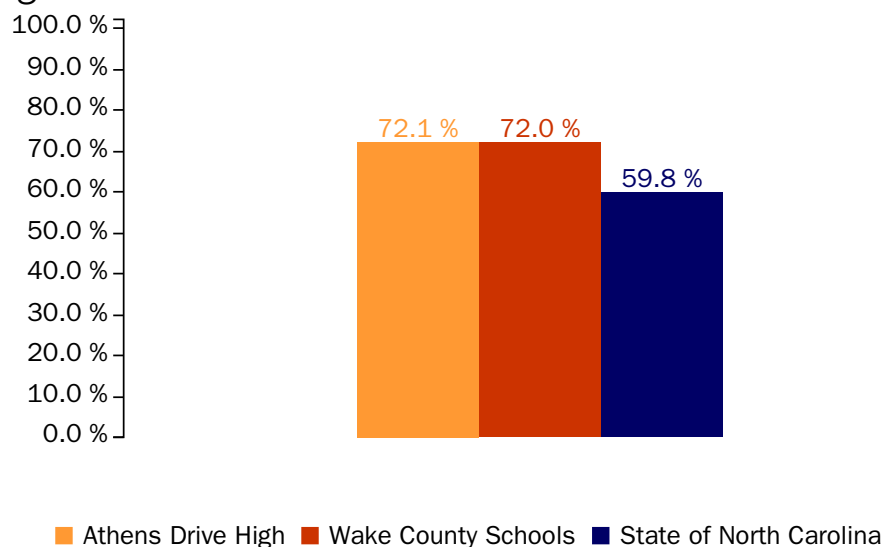

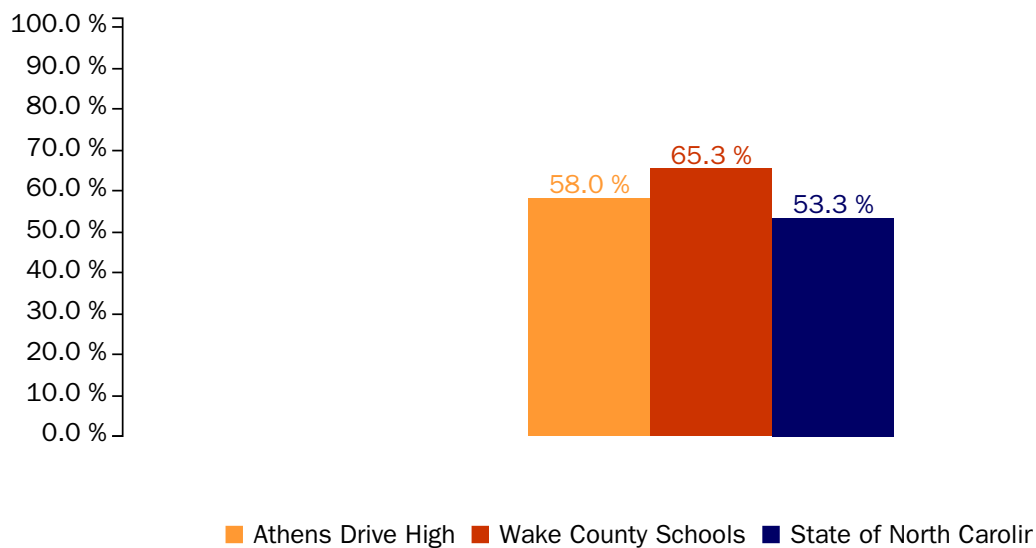

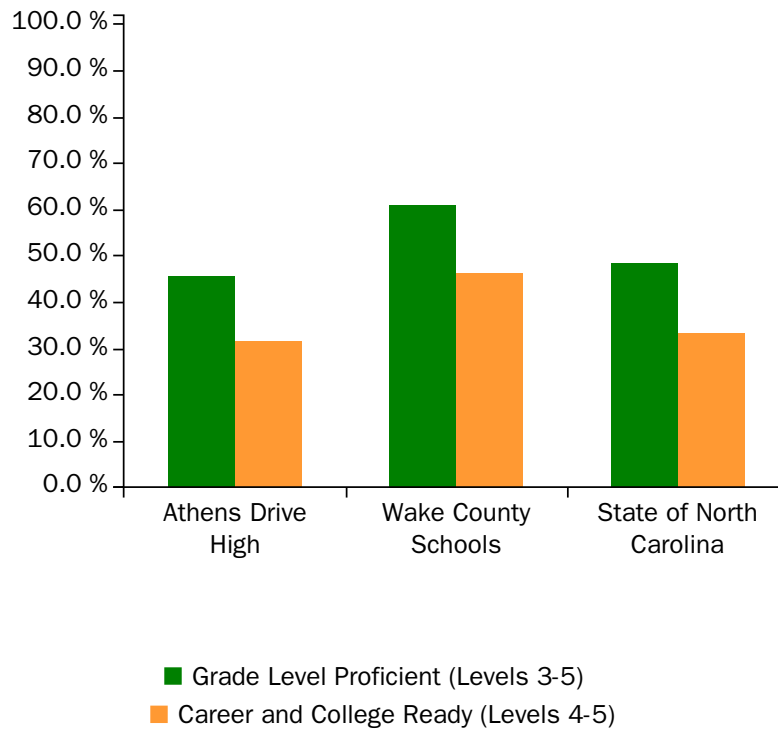

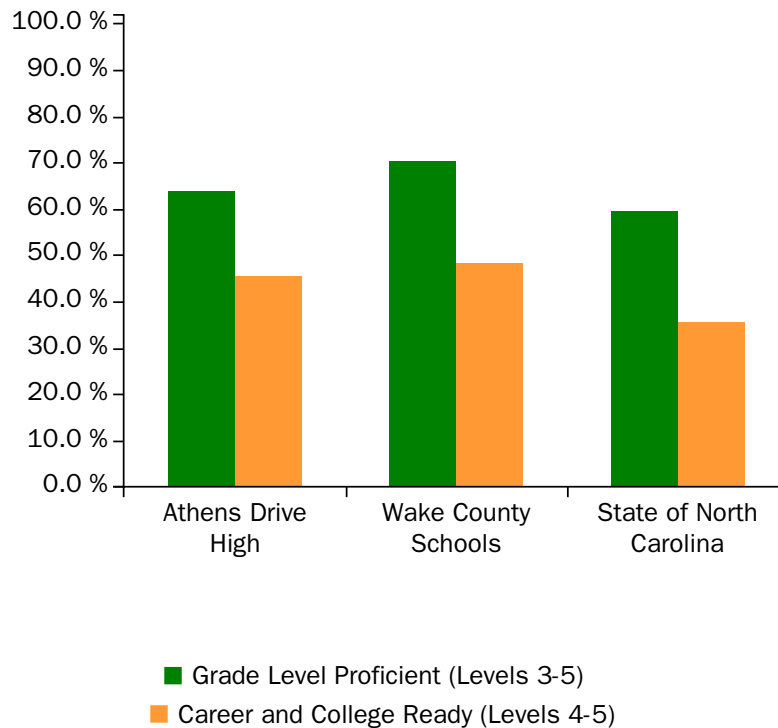

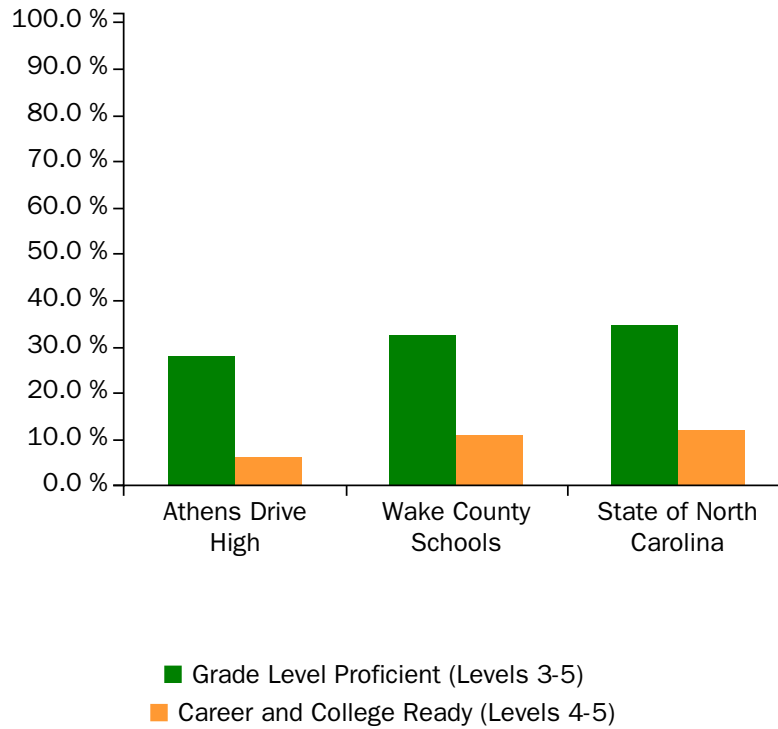

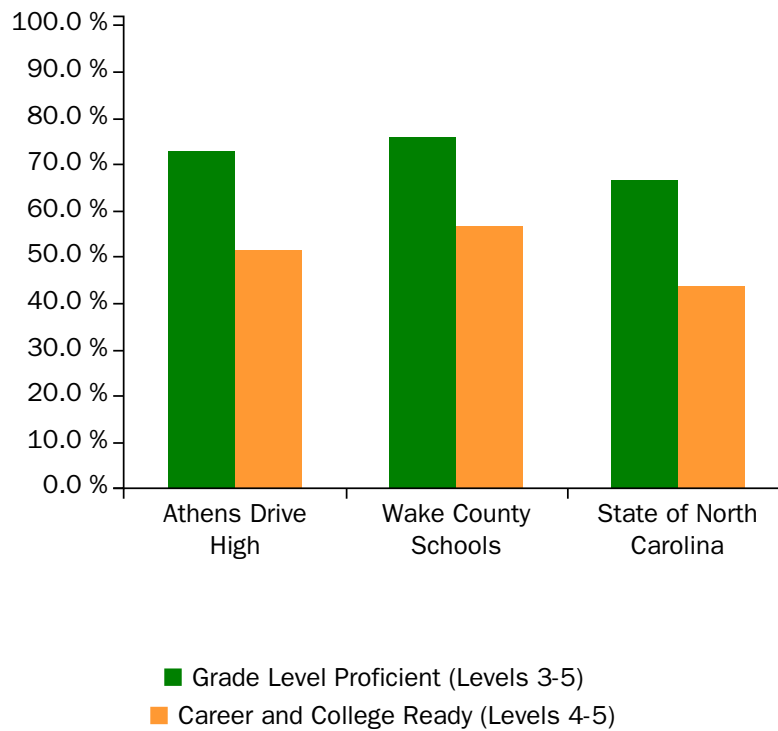

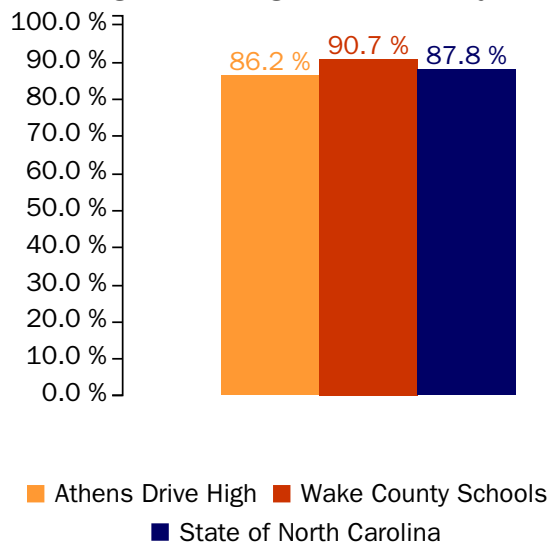

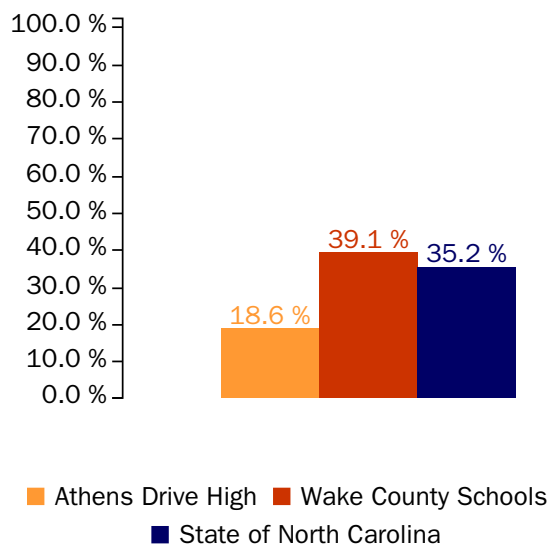

Percent graduating within four years at Athens Drive High

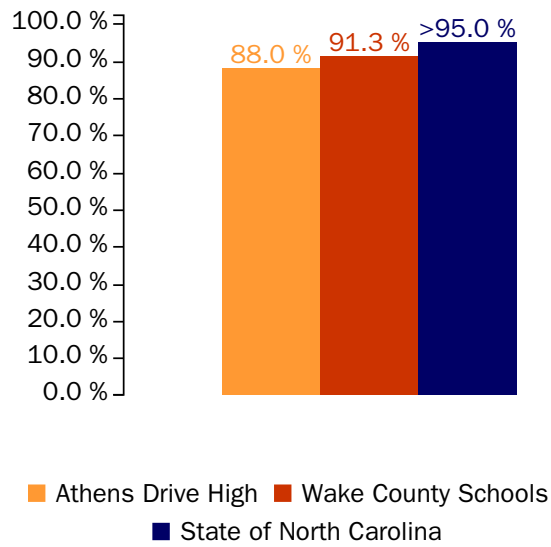


English Learner Proficiency ⓘ

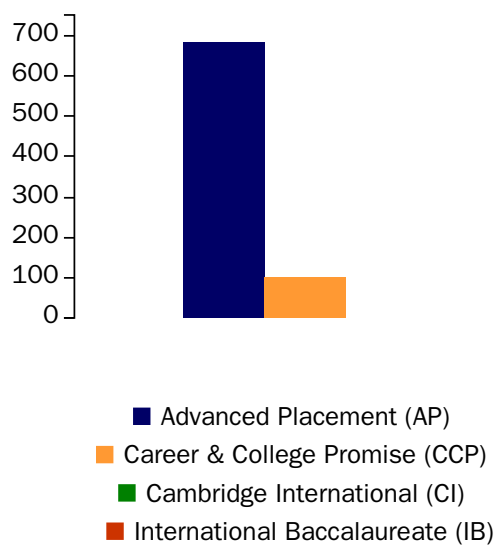

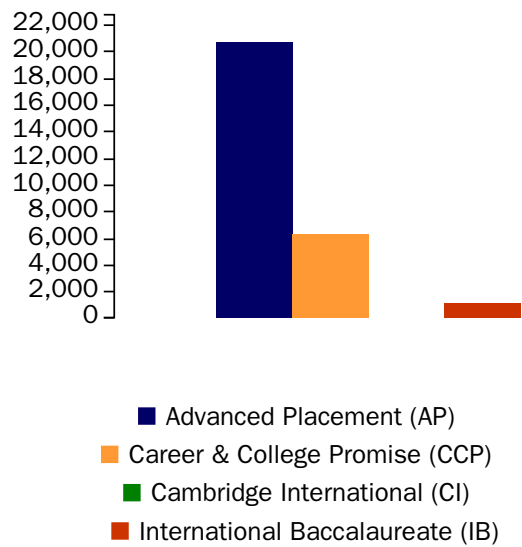

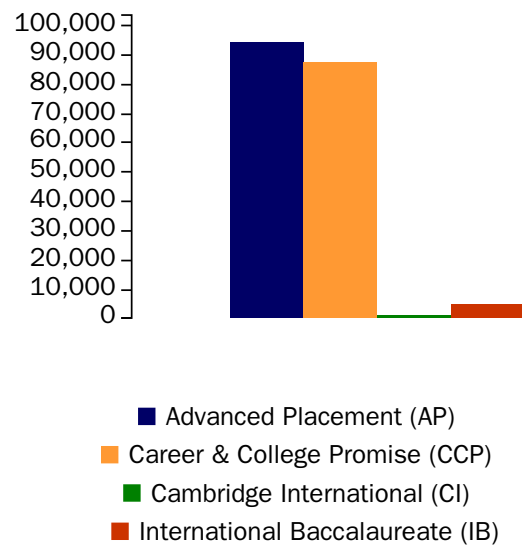

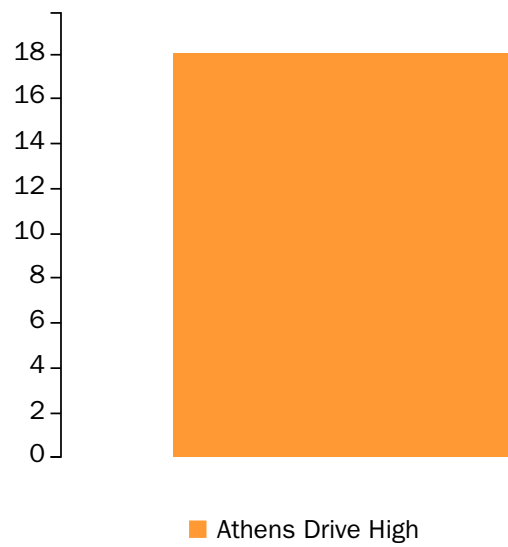

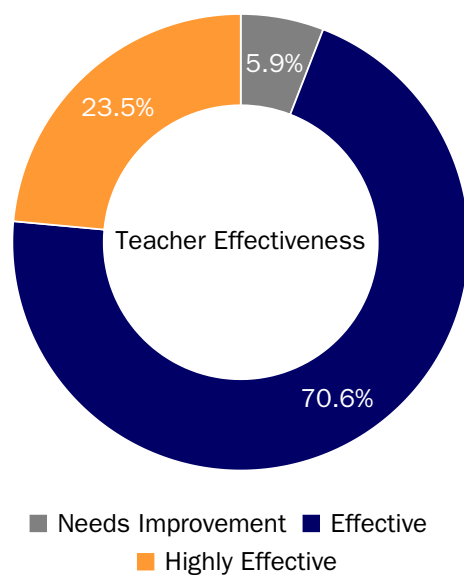

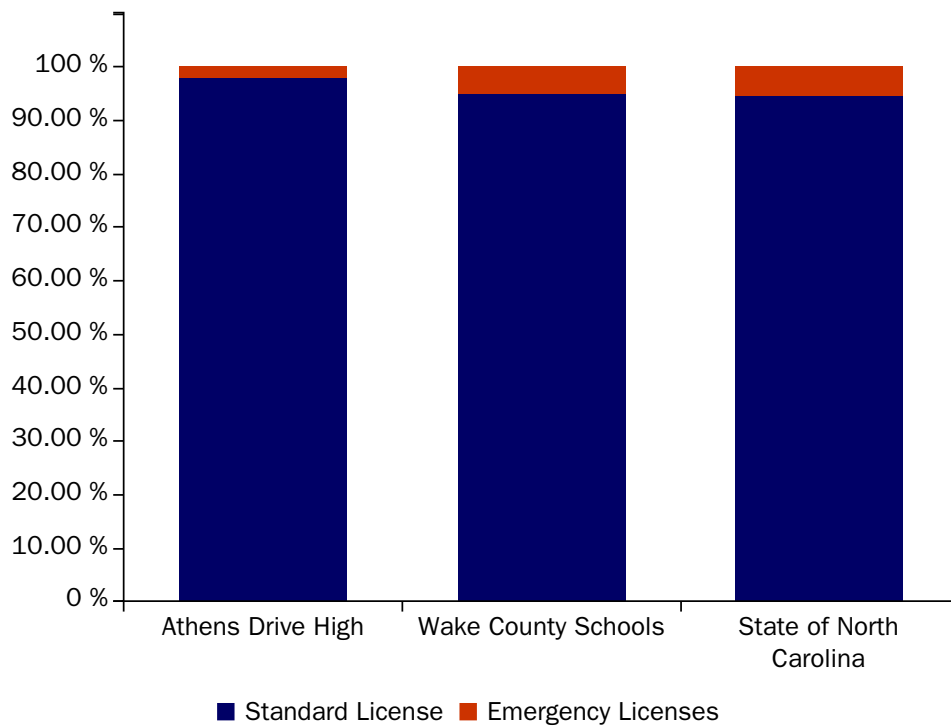

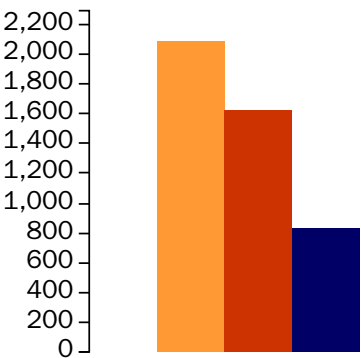

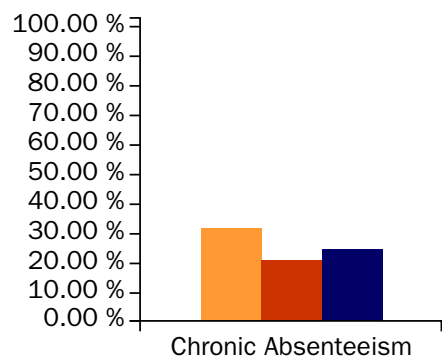

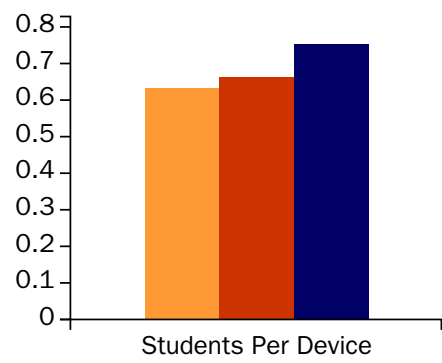

Book Titles Per Student ⓘ

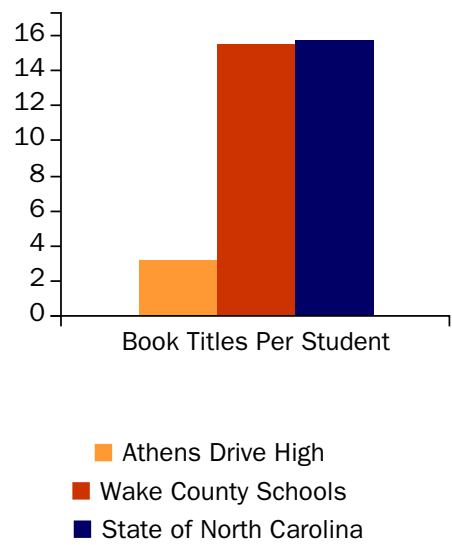

Wireless Access Points per Classroom ⓘ

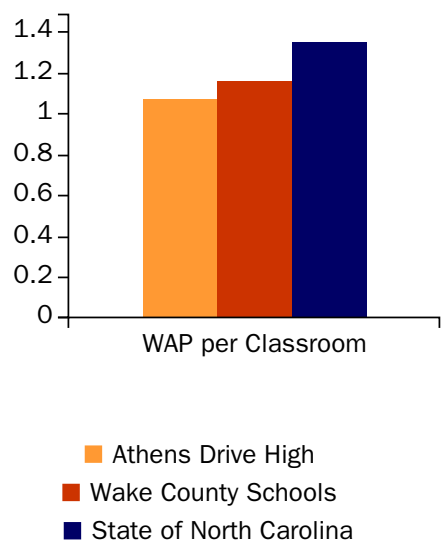

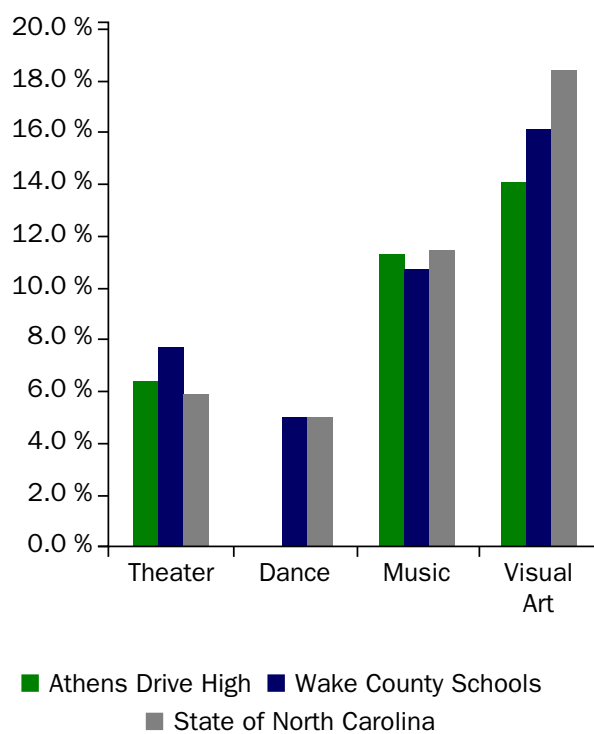

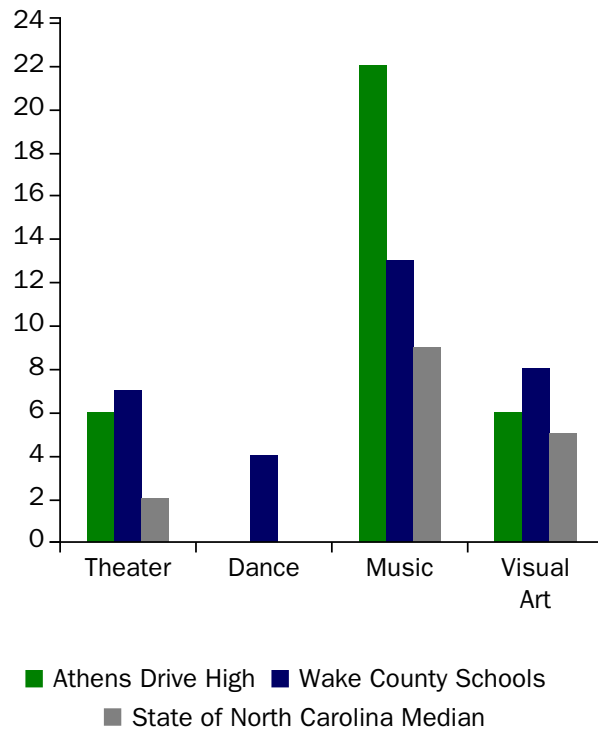
