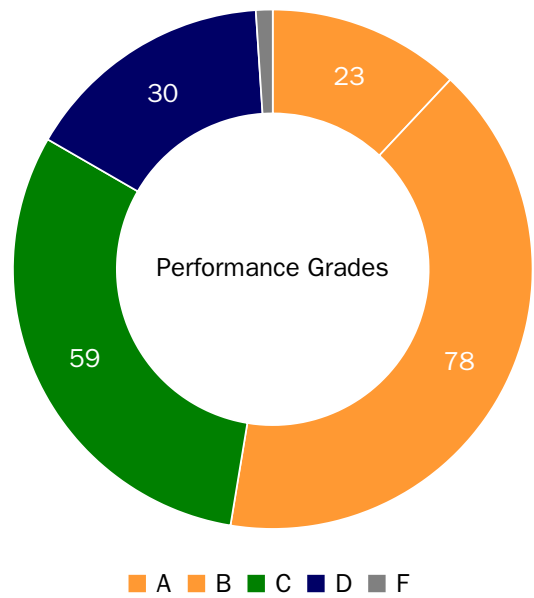

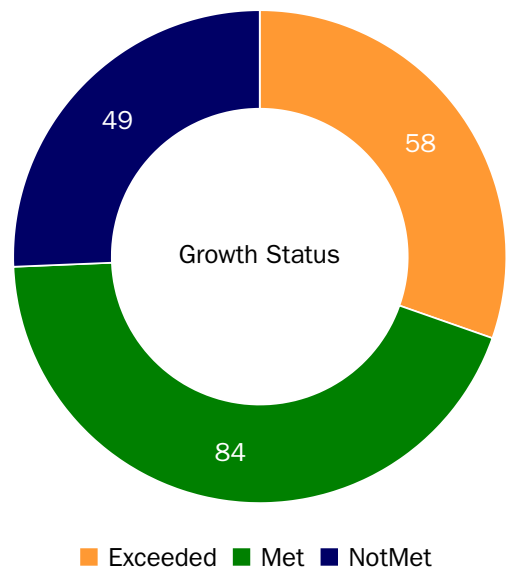

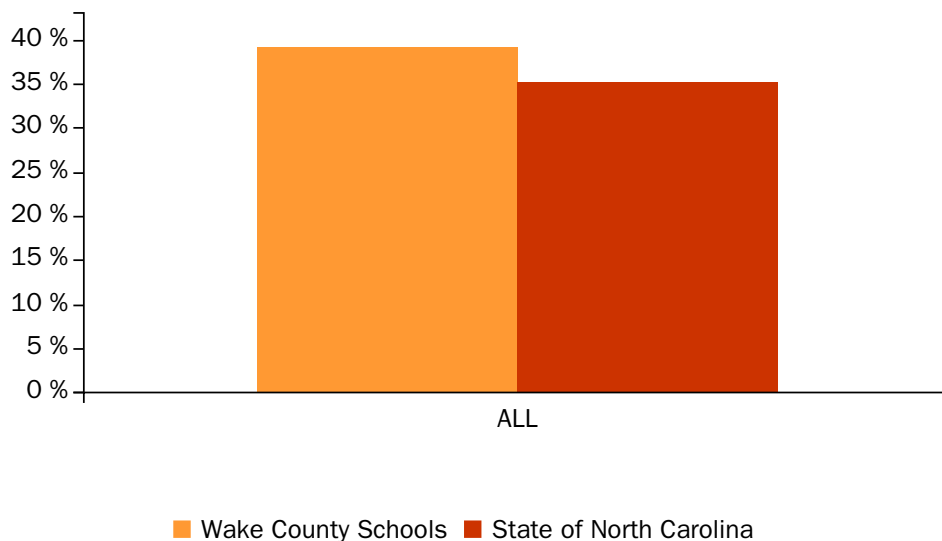

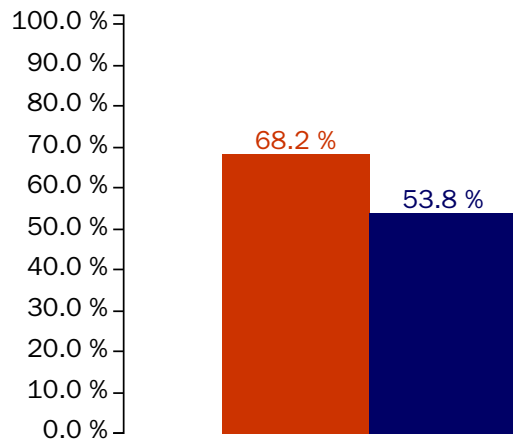

Percent Scoring 17 or above in Wake County Schools

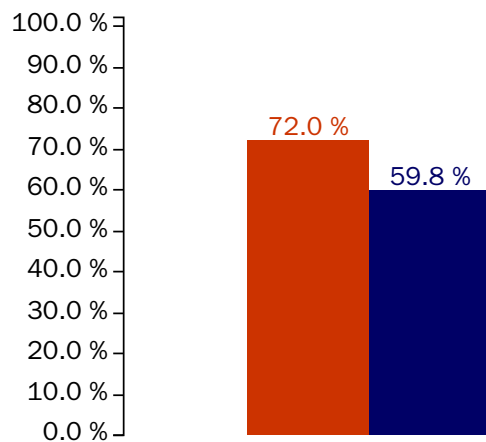

Percent earning a Silver certificate or higher in Wake County Schools



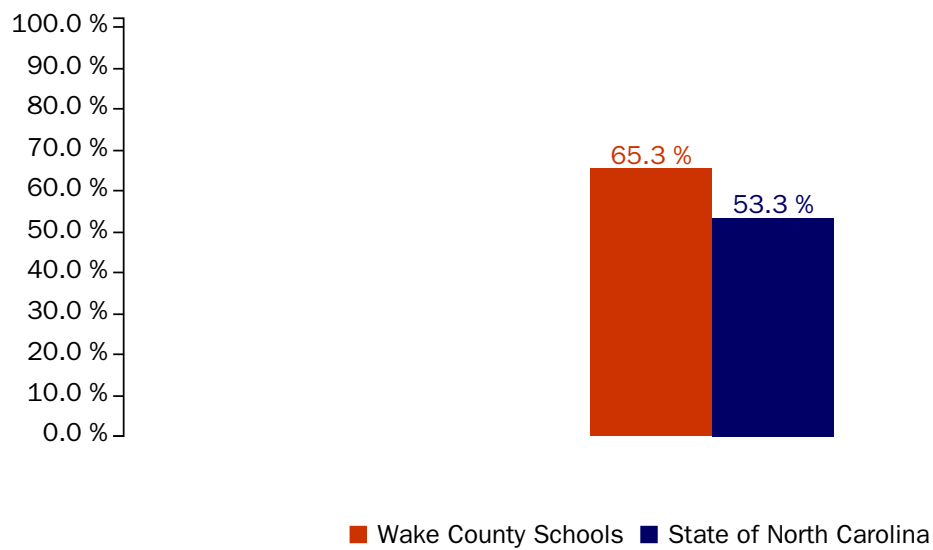

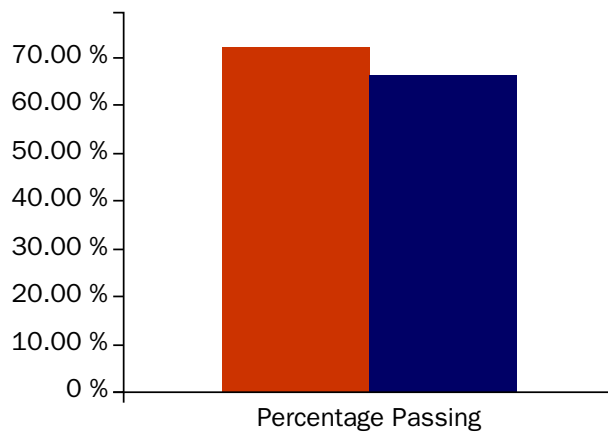

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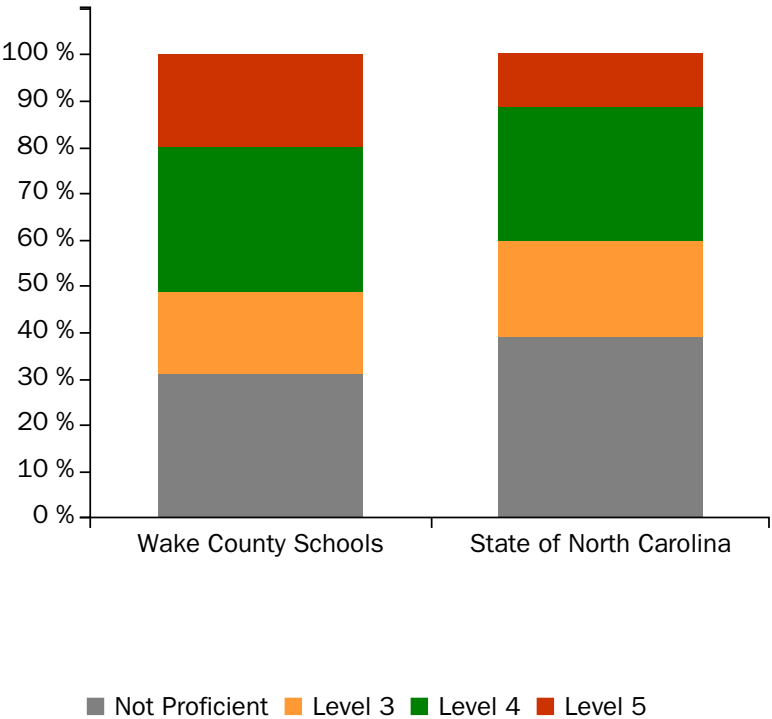
Reading Performance ⓘ

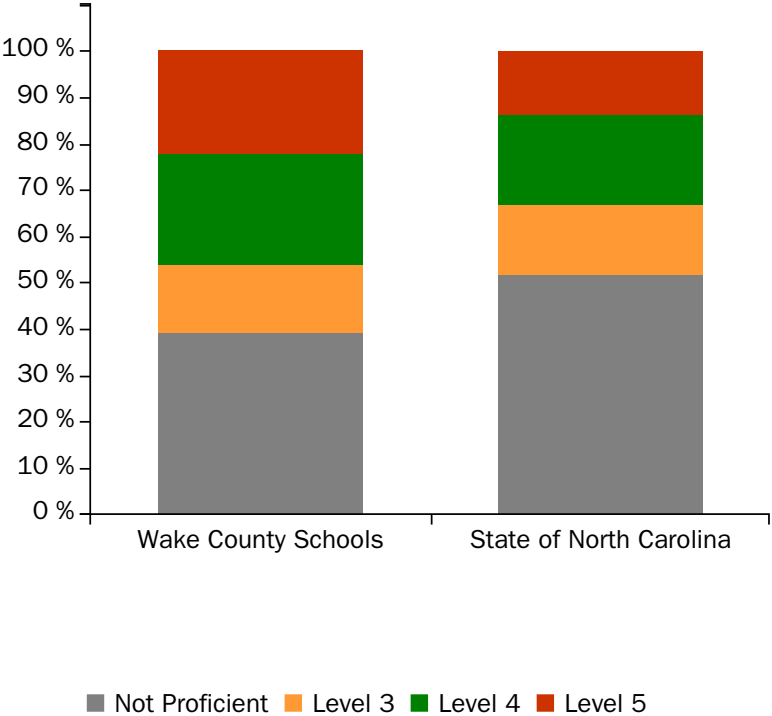

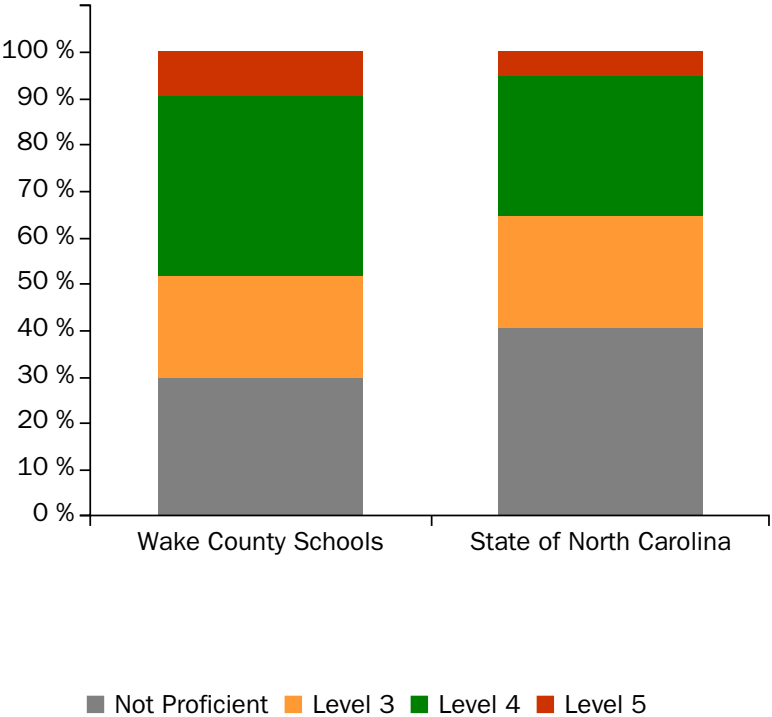
Biology Performance

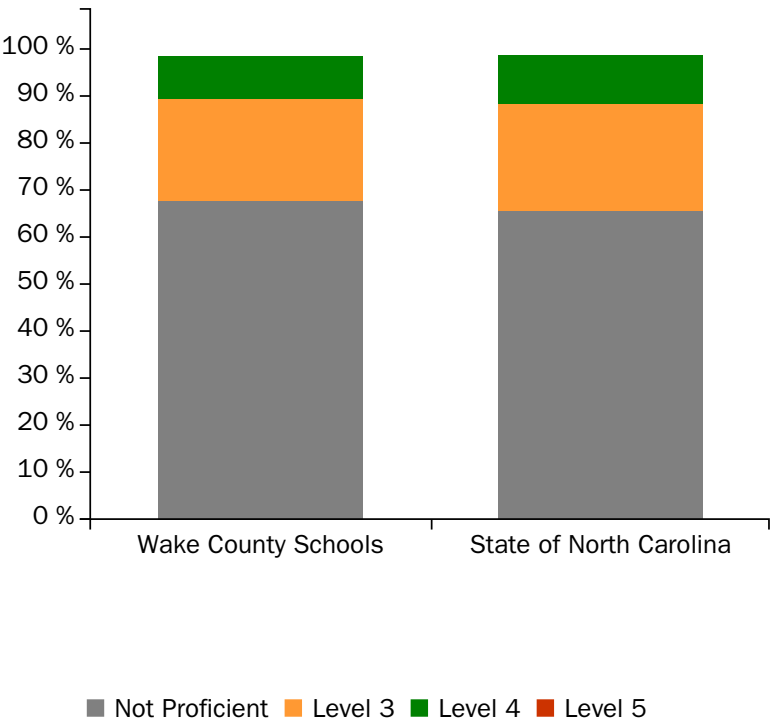

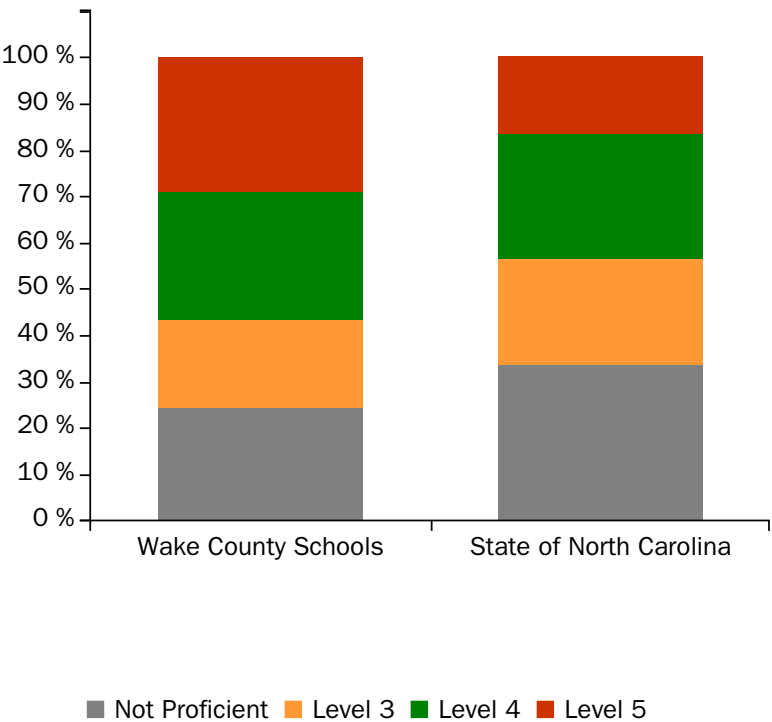
NC Math 1 Performance

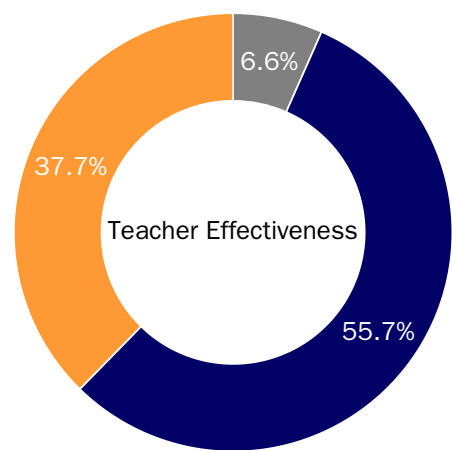

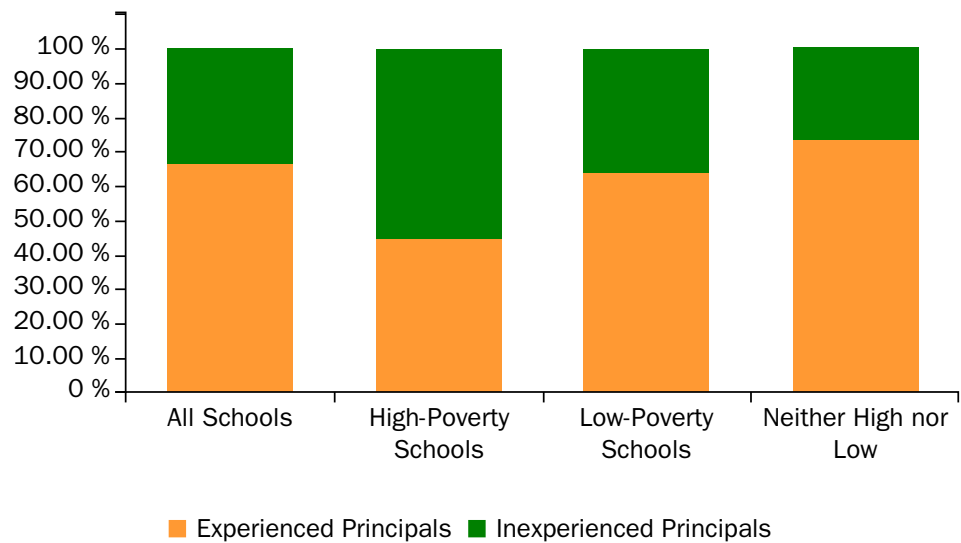

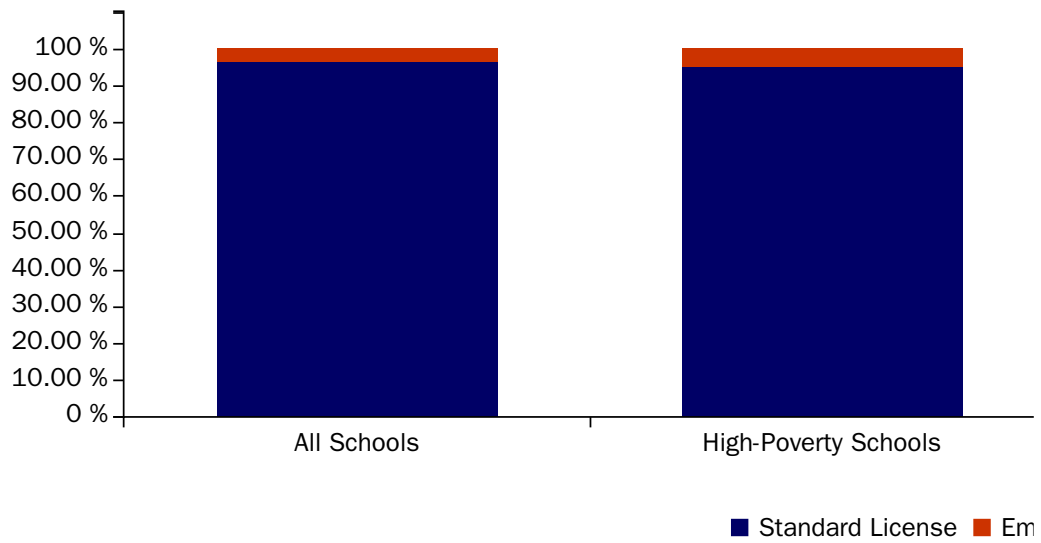

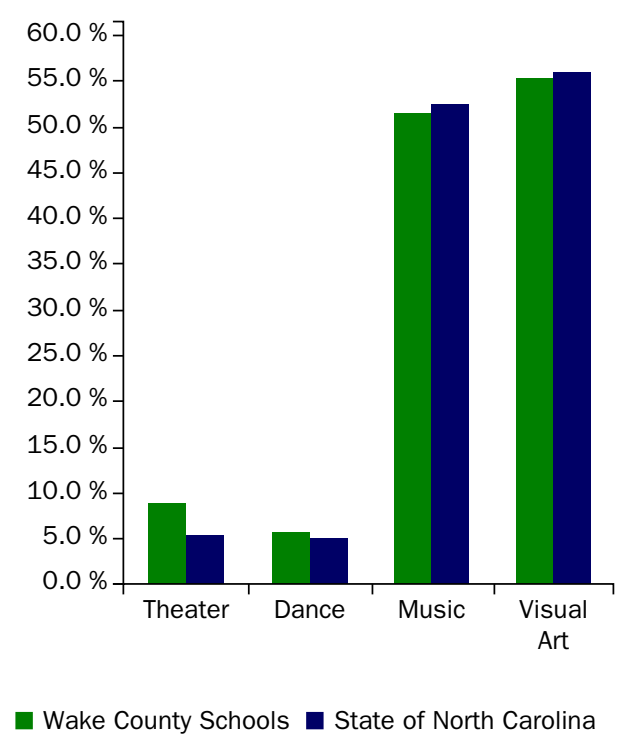

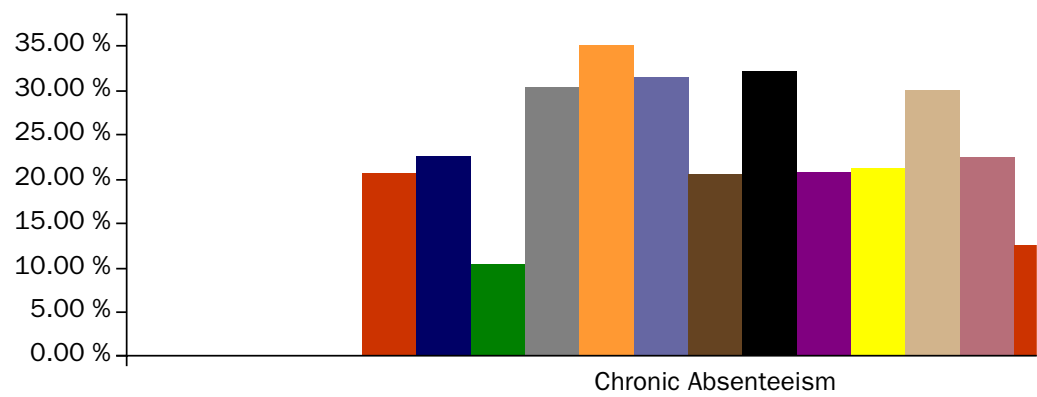
